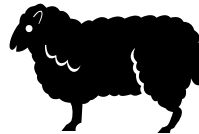

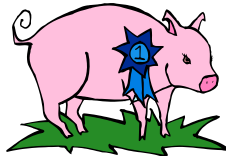

Rules & Regulations (Open Meat Goat Show)

This show is for meat type goats only

All animals must meet all WV Dept of Agriculture health requirements.

Animals shown in the Boer and Kiko classes must have registration papers. All others will be entered in the commercial classes using recorded birthdates.

Only animals that are entered in their respective classes will be allowed on the fairgrounds; with the exception that the does of the kids in the 0-3 month classes may be allowed to be on the fairgrounds for their kids.

Goats shown in this department can only be shown in this department's classes and are NOT eligible for the 4-H/FFA Market Animal Sale.

1. All goats must be dehorned or properly tipped and properly healed to show or be fitted with approved horn guards. No sharp points allowed.
2. All meat goats must meet the current WV Dept. of Agriculture Health Requirements.
3. Goats with signs of foot rot, sore mouth, open sores, or other illness will not be allowed to exhibit.
4. Market, Meat Goats & Open Class Meat Goats will be shown by weight classes determined at weigh-in.
5. Goats will be penned 2 head per pen maximum.
