RULES

1. All articles must be the handiwork of the exhibitor and must not have been previously entered into competition.
2. All sections are designated as amateur. Amateur is defined as a recreational hobby, not for livelihood or occupational therapy.
3. When there is no competition, a ribbon may be given if worthy. If, in a class, no exhibits are worthy, ribbons will not be awarded. The decision of the judges is final.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR

The Premier Exhibitor will be determined by totaling the ribbon points for everyone entering 10 or more or 5 or more exhibits, respectively. Points will be based on Blue-3, Red-2, and White-1. The total number of points will be divided by the total number of entries. The person with the highest average will be the Premier Exhibitor. This method of selection will encourage the exhibiting of the highest quality of craftsmanship.
